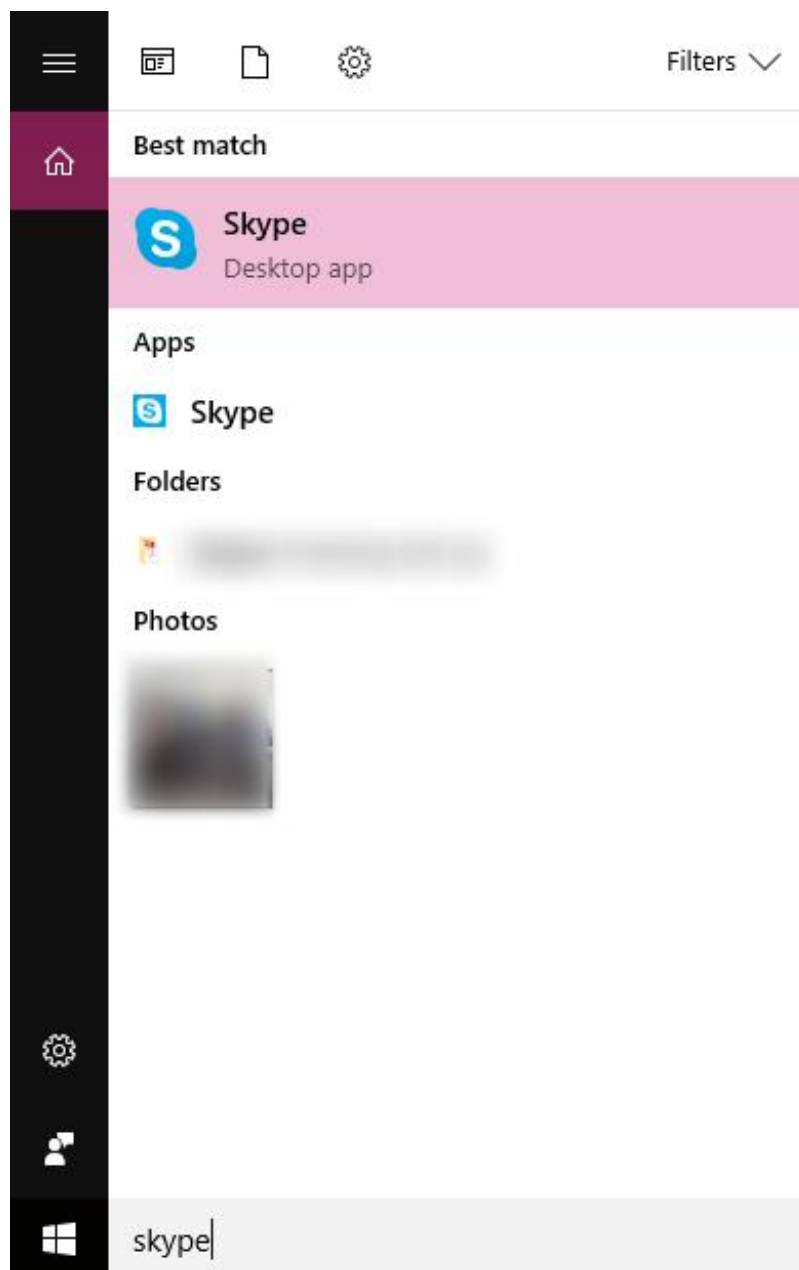


Getting Set Up With Skype

Installing Skype



If you have Windows 10, you most likely already have Skype installed, do a simple search from the Start menu.

Computer vs iPad/iPhone
